#### **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!**

Looking for dedicated people to help care for the animals and keep the place clean and organized. Many shifts are available for both inside (cats) & outside (horses, poultry).



**CHAMP** is one seriously cool cat! He was found on our property, and was taken to the vets to be neutered & vaccinated so he could be released back on the farm. But Champ showed his soft sweet side and we realized this boy needs a real home. He is so big we had to build an enclosure for him! We think he might be best in a home without other animals, and definitely not with an elderly person – he insists on rubbing himself on your legs and feet even while walking.

### SMILES, TEARS, CHAOS AND SUCCESS

Like every year, 2024 brought many new challenges to our organization. So far this year Oasis authorized 129 pets and feral cats for sterilization, bringing the total number of animals going through that Program to over 8,100. The company has so far taken in 33 animals, adopted 18, and assisted in the rehoming of 14 puppies and dogs from another rescue. We witnessed 2 mama cats giving birth to a total of 10 kittens, and felt the sadness of one of those babies not making it. This year we made 5 gut-wrenching, heart breaking decisions to euthanize terminally sick or suffering animals – 2 horses, a chicken, and two cats. One of our kittens came down with FIP, a deadly disease that can now be cured with some rather expensive medicine. (He is still on it and doing well.) And we hurriedly brought in 8 cats from another rescue that was unexpectedly shutting down. 5 of the 8 needed immediate medical care.

During a heat wave in late June, we were very grateful to have been bequeathed a nice sum of money - we had great plans for reducing our debt! Within a week the central air conditioning broke beyond repair and it also became undeniably evident that the roof needed to be replaced. So we became very grateful to have been bequeathed a nice

sum of money - to pay for those 2 significant expenditures. And it did.

In late September our 31-year-old thoroughbred Belvedere developed a lump on his face. The vet was unable to care for that or any teeth issues – even sedated he was tossing her around! Belvedere needed to go to the hospital as the lump grew quickly into a huge abscess and exploded, leaving a gruesome, FOUL smelling 2" hole in his face! The vets at New Bolton took out 3 teeth, and the x-rays revealed the abscess wasn't from the bad teeth – it was from a sliver of bone that somehow dislodged from his cheekbone! This was his body's way of getting rid of it. Thankfully he came home that night to his frantic equine buddy and Foster Mon, and needed antibodies for a whole month. His wound is now just a tiny mark that should eventually disappear.

The current economy is still having a dire effect on our organization. Increasing prices on food, hay, supplies and medical care must be juggled with a decreasing amount of donations being given. We've tried some new fundraisers this year in addition to our regular repertoire; while successful, Oassi still needs under the price of the street of the s animals need daily food & care, medical attention, and general support; we also need funding for our operating expense to cover required insurances, utilities, programs and

other items. So again, we are reaching out to please remember Oasis during the holiday season, and help our mission to continue.

As of November 20, 2024 we are at 83% of our budget for the year, but expenses are outpacing our income. The animals still need daily care, medical attention, and general support; we also need funding for our operating expense to cover required insurances, heating, utilities and other items. So again, we are reaching out to our generous donors to please remember Oasis during the holiday season, and help our mission to continue. For example, \$8 buys a bale of hay (we go thru 5 a day in winter); \$22 buys a bag of chicken or duck feed; \$28 buys a 50 lb. bag of horse feed (we go thru 1 a day); \$50 covers a male cat neuter; \$100 buys enough cat food or litter for a week. Indeed, a very expensive undertaking!

As we have said before, we at Oasis feel blessed to have the chance to help the animals on their journey through Life. Our gift in return – unconditional love – is a priceless treasure that is only understood by the heart. Thank you in advance for

your generosity.
